2. Upon Arrival and Departure at the Adisucipto International Airport, Yogyakarta

a. VISA

Delegates holding passport from the ASEAN-member nations, Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR can proceed to Foreign Immigration Desk as they are eligible for entry to Indonesia without visa fees for 30 days.

Nationals from other nations should proceed to the booth marked Visa on Arrival, located on the right side of the terminal entrance from the tarmac. Be ready with your US\$25 and note that they only accept US currency issued after the year 2000.

b. Transportation to the Hotel

Proceed to the Airport Taxi stand near the terminal exit door and book an airport taxi. The attendant at the booth will escort you to what may look like a private car, standard rate is fixed at IDR100,000 (US\$10). You can change currency at the airport for taxi fare, but money changers near hotel have better rates.

Metered taxis are also available, but you have to walk out of the airport area (go to main road) or wait for them in the departure area to flag them down. They are not allowed to enter airport without a passenger. If you take this option, don't pay for more than IDR50,000 to the Malioboro area.

c. **Hotel**

There is no official hotel for the conference. But the Secretariat will be located at the Ibis Style Hotel (109 Jalan Dagen) in the Malioboro area. A bus will be provided by the Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta (UMY) from this hotel to bring participants to conference venue. Conversely, taxis are cheap and you can go to venue directly. Please book a hotel in the Malioboro area for easy access to Secretariat and also to UMY.

d. **Conference Venue**

- Opening Day registration will be held at the 4th Floor, Graduate School building, Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta *Jalan Lingkar Selatan, Kasihan, Bantul, Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta 55183, Indonesia*
- **On-site registration will be on cash basis only in USD. Registration and collection of ID and kits will begin at 12 noon on 27 October 2016.**
- **Conference Opening Ceremony begins at 3pm, 27 October 2016.**
- **Conference Closing Ceremony will be on 29 October 2016 at 1pm.**
- The Secretariat is arranging an **Optional Tour to Borubodur** for those interested at a minimal additional cost. We will inform participants once final arrangements have been made.
- Conference fees include participation fee, conference kits, certificates, lunches and coffee breaks. All meals will be Halal.

e. **Conference Programme**

Official programme (with parallel session schedules) will be emailed to participants on or before September 30.

f. **Dress code**

Delegates are expected to be in smart casual or business attire during the plenary and parallel sessions. There is no need to wear national dress for the opening day dinner but you may opt to do so.

Kindly refrain from attending the both plenary and parallel sessions in shorts, T-shirts, sleeveless tops and slippers.
