VISA FOR INDONESIA

Delegates holding passport from the ASEAN-member nations, Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR can proceed to Foreign Immigration Desk as they are eligible for entry to Indonesia without visa fees for 30 days.

Nationals from other nations should proceed to the booth marked Visa on Arrival, located on the right side of the terminal entrance from the tarmac. Be ready with your US\$25 and note that they only accept US currency issued after the year 2000.

Transportation to the Hotel

- Proceed to the Airport Taxi stand near the terminal exit door and book an
- Metered taxis are also available at the departure area (next door to arrival area),
- Minimum rate for airport taxis/private cars for hire to Malioboro is IDR100,000 (or US\$10).

You can change currency at the airport for taxi fare, but money changers near hotel have better rates. Best money changer rates for USD can be found inside the compound of Inna Garuda Hotel Malioboro.

Yogyakarta airport charges a IDR100,000 terminal fee for international flights and IDR40,000 for domestic flights (Jakarta, Denpasar).
