1. Paper Submissions

All participants should submit an Extended Abstract for the Conference Proceedings on or before September 15, 2024.

The Extended Abstract should summarize the main points of your paper and should:

- Describe the Aims/Goal of the paper and its significance
- Discuss the theoretical framework/foundation of the paper
- Discuss the initial (if on-going) findings of the paper
- Summarize the recommendations for further research if any

Format for Extended Abstract

- Top of the page (left-hand side) should have: paper title, author's full name and affiliation, for example:
Vaccine Fake News and the Zombie Threat in Surigao, Philippines
By Juana de la Cruz, PhD
University of Surigao, Philippines
- Length: 1000-1200 words
- Should include relevant/important figures, tables if any
- Limit to 3 to 5 pages, single-spaced except between paragraphs
- Include Reference List in APA (5th to 7th edition) format (*this is not included in the word count*)

Those who wish to be considered for publication in the ACMC Journal should submit a FULL paper (3,500-7,000 words) directly to info@asianmediacongress.org

2. Presentations

All presentations (onsite or online) should be timed for a maximum of 10-minutes presentation. Ideally, presenters should limit themselves to 10-12 slides to prevent overtime. An open forum of 10-12 minutes will follow the presentations for each panel.

Those opting to attend the conference online should submit a pre-recorded video of their presentation on or before October 15, 2022.

Format for Video presentation:

1. Start by introducing yourself and the goal of your research before starting the presentation
2. Share screen Powerpoint (if any) – with video on, so that you can also be seen.

3. Limit video to a maximum of 10 minutes in length.
4. The video files can be saved as an FLV or mp4 file. You may use any application you are comfortable with, but a simple Zoom recording will suffice.

a. VISA

b. CURRENCY

The Đồng (VND) has been the currency of Vietnam since 3 May 1978. It is issued by the State Bank of Vietnam.

As of August 2024: US\$1 = VNĐ25,050

It is best to change currency at the Tan Son Nhat International Airport arrival area. Otherwise, please go to a bank for exchange, such as:

- Vietinbank Bui Vien: 36 Bui Vien St, Pham Ngu Lao Ward, District 1
- Saigonbank Pham Ngu Lao: 333 Pham Ngu Lao St, Pham Ngu Lao Ward, District 1

c. HOTELS

Book a hotel in Ho Chi Minh, District 1 to be near the conference venue. The best deals can be found on Agoda.com or Booking.com

d. GETTING AROUND

If you do not speak Vietnamese, the best way to get around is **via GRAB (bike or car)**. The various sites and hotels are easily found on the GRAB app and will also spare you from having to compute their confusing currency (with all the 0000s).

For first-time visitors, do try the **Hop On, Hop Off** bus to get an overview of the city easily. You can sign up for a tour at the historical POST OFFICE (Saigon Central Post Office, 02 Công xã Paris, Bến Nghé, Quận 1, Hồ Chí Minh 70000, Vietnam)

e. OTHER TIPS

1. **SIM card:** For easy WIFI access, get a data SIM card at the Airport for around USD5 or VND250,000.
2. For Philippine travelers: Do not forget to register at the <<https://etravel.gov.ph/>> to facilitate immigration procedure before departure and before arrival.
